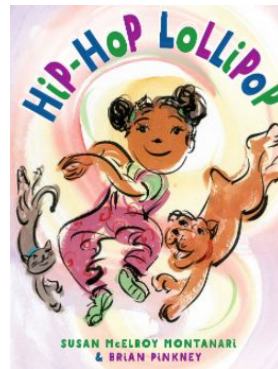


PreK 4 - We Are Experts on How to Identify Fiction from Non-Fiction!
