Even though in the 2010's the velodrome was undergoing some transformation, including getting flooded in August 2017, the racers were still heating it up on the track.



Rita Kacala (50-54 women) set a world record in winning the 500m TT at Master's Nationals in 2009. She won again in 2010, 2011, 2012 and 2013. Jonathan Fraley also won a few Master's Sprint Championships in 2009, 2010 and 2011, in the 30-34 age category. In 2013, Robert Springer also brought home a Master's National Championship Jersey in the 40-44 Individual Pursuit. Also, Springer was the driver in the blind tandem Para Track National Championship in 2012.

Peter Bock found his speed in 2015, as he was part of the championship winning Team Sprint in 2015 at the Collegiate Nationals. He again won in 2018. But 2019 was his year, in winning the Match Sprint and Team Sprint at Elite Nationals in the summer and winning those same events again at Collegiate Nationals in the fall. Sarah Huang followed up her 2006 Junior National Track Championship with a win in the Junior National Scratch Race, Points and Team Pursuit in 2013. This went on to earn her a spot on the USA World Track Team to compete in Points,

Scratch and Team Pursuit events in Glasgow, Scotland.

Types of Races

Miss and Out - Easily the crowd favorite.

This is an elimination race where the last rider on every lap is "pulled" from the race. The excitement takes place at the back of the pack as one by one the rider whose rear wheel crosses the line last is eliminated. The race continues until there are only three riders left, and then a sprint to the finish.

Scratch Race - The easiest of races. The race involves a predetermined number of laps and the rider who comes across the finish line first on the final lap wins. Riders try to break away from the group while teammates try to slow down the field or make other teams work to catch the break away rider.

Points - Usually the last and the longest race of the night, this is an endurance race on the track. The race has a predetermined number of laps with sprint laps every 5 or 10 laps. Riders sprint for points during the sprint lap. The bell is rung and riders sprint for 5, 3, 2, 1 pts. respectively. With the final sprint being double points. It is usually the longest race; this is the best opportunity for riders with the most endurance to break away. Any rider who gains a lap on the field gains an extra 20 points. The rider with the most points at the end wins. This can be a confusing race to understand at first, as sometimes the one that finishes first may not be the winner.
